YOUTH SERVICES COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Monday, September 12, 2010, 6:30 PM

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM.

I. Summer Concerns

- A. The Chair reported on the use of CB 7's office by the Children's Arts and Sciences Workshop over the summer. After meetings with the CB 7 Chair, the District Manager, and staff from CASW, our memorandum of intent was modified to reflect the costs incurred by CASW more accurately. This summer was the last of three that were included in the MOI. Renewal of the MOI will be discussed at a future meeting of the Committee.
- B. The Committee had been concerned that the citywide budget cuts to youth summer programs would lead to increased youth crime. However, the 52nd Precinct reported that our area did not experience any unusual elevation in crime rates.

II. FY 2013 Program Priorities

- A. The Chair opened a discussion on the FY 13 service program priorities, which each CB must submit to the city by the end of October.
- B. If any CB 7 members who are not on the Youth Services Committee would like more information regarding any of the youth-related programs on the list, they are encouraged to ask Committee members for more information.

III. Committee Goals for FY 2012

- A. Committee members were asked to propose specific goals and issues to be our focus for this year. Suggestions included physical and mental healthcare, availability and funding of youth programs, and youth involvement with CB 7.
- B. The Committee will work to implement technology solutions to allow video- and teleconferencing for our meetings.

IV. Additional Items

- A. The Chair reported on the most recent developments in the trichloroethylene contamination at P. S. 51 (Bronx New School).
- B. Committee members who would prefer to change the meeting day should contact the Chair as soon as possible.
